

FEATURE HIKE & PICNIC AREA: 2

The Belleisle Marsh and Walking Trail just 12km from Annapolis Royal on Hwy 1 Evangeline Trail travels over protected marsh and waterfowl land. The trail is great for walking, hiking and mountain biking. The dirt ox-cart track trail over the flat land makes an easy family walk or biking experience. The trail winds its way along the dyke system on the marsh of this land and is known as a bird watchers paradise. Besides the fertile farmland, the Belleisle Marsh is also an important historical site and Acadian archeological site. You can see some of the Acadian artifacts found here on display at the Belleisle Hall. Total Length: 8.2 km
